▲ **RE-CREATE THE MOVIE THEATER EXPERIENCE IN YOUR MEDIA ROOM:** Drape handmade red velvet curtains around the television. Simple DIY film-themed art (plastic film reels spray-painted white, then hung in clusters on the wall) and inexpensive plastic Oscar-esque statuettes set the mood for the big event. >> Serve Japanese sake (a delightful departure from champagne; Uwajimaya has a fantastic selection) and of course, movie popcorn. For a fun twist, create a popcorn bar with sweet and savory toppings.



◀ **SMALL DETAILS MAKE AN OSCAR-SIZED IMPRESSION:** Invitations sealed with a gold sticker (à la the Academy Awards) beckon "nominees" to attend; strips of old film wrapped on the inside of clear circular luminaries lend old-school Hollywood flair (plus when lit, they project the images on the wall!); for favors, send guests off with a Chinese food takeout box filled with fortune cookies and a personalized statuette of their own.

▼ **GLAM UP YOUR ENTRY WITH PERSONALIZED HOLLYWOOD STARS:** I painted a red stripe on the stairs and made each guest their own paper Hollywood star to create a red carpet entrance. Since fashion statements are the most important part of the evening (for some of us, at least), I created a best-dressed wall of famous dresses and borrowed a slinky Roberto Cavalli gown from Le Frock to finish the display.
